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<u>PSD delivers a 2-day training</u> workshop with CYSD in Odisha



PSD delivered a 2-day training workshop with Centre for Youth and Social Development (CYSD) for 19 Anganwadi workers in Puri, Odisha to build their capacity to deliver a physical activity curriculum to children at their local centres.

The workshop was facilitated by Bhaktamohan Swain and Swagatika Khatei, our community sports trainers in Odisha. The workshop involved practical as well as theory sessions, which focused on concepts of coaching and the importance of effective communication between a coach and a player.

The 2-day workshop also focused on training the Anganwadi workers on how to inculcate fun based learning and a safe environment while effectively delivering a physical activity curriculum to children.

Over the last five years PSD has delivered training workshops to 739(27% females) individuals providing them with the appropriate tools to effectively deliver sports programs to youth, by enhancing their knowledge and delivery techniques.

This month we conducted another impact analysis survey at Anantapur Sports Academy in collaboration with the Rural Development Trust.

The survey further aims to ascertain the role of grassroots sports programs on children's social, emotional and physical development.

Through this survey we were able to reach out to 235 children (41.7 % girls) from 12 key centers in the Anantapur district of Andhra Pradesh.
