PSD Kickstarts KBC campaign Phase 1 Sports Camps

PSD in collaboration with PRIA (Society for Participatory Research in Asia) and MFF (Martha Farrell Foundation) kicked off the Kadam Badhate Chalo (KBC) campaign Phase 1 sports camps in 3 different locations, covering a total of 194 youth, of which 90 were girls and 104 boys.



The camps began in Najafgarh, Delhi, then moved to Chitrakoot and Banda in Uttar Pradesh. The Phase 1 sports camps focused on utilizing fun and engaging sports games to overcome inhibitions among the youth groups, building a lasting bond between them and transfer the core values of sport such as leadership, fairplay, camaraderie, equality, teamwork & communication.



The camps will move to other locations in the coming months, including Sonepat and Panipat in Haryana, Jhansi in Uttar Pradesh, Muzzafarpur in Bihar and Raipur in Chattisgarh.
