

PSD Delivers KBC Sports & Gender Camps in Haryana

PSD, in collaboration with PRIA (Society for Participatory Research in Asia) and MFF (Martha Farrell Foundation), delivered the KBC Phase 1 Sports & Gender Camp in the two KBC locations in Haryana, Sonapat and Panipat.

The camp in Sonapat was held from the 10th to 11th of December, 2016, whereas the camp in Panipat was held from the 12th to 13th of December, 2016. The camp in Sonapat saw the participation of a total of 70 youth, with 32 girls and 38 boys, and the camp in Panipat saw the participation of a total of 73 youth, with 42 girls and 31 boys.



The relevance of these camps in Haryana can be understood in the backdrop of the ground work done by PRIA and MFF with youth groups in Haryana, which found that that their communities have faced gender based violence in various forms such as dropouts of girl children from school, child marriages, unwanted/trapped pregnancies due to lack of awareness as well as honour killings!
