# Summer Camps for Community Participants in Bhubaneswar

As part of the Community Sports Program, supported by Tata Trusts, Pro Sport Development (PSD) is conducting summer camps at 6 centres with more than 200 children over 7 weeks in May and June 2018. The summer camps will teach children basic skills in the 3 sports of Volleyball, Netball and Football, while further focusing on developing various soft skills and sporting values.



The participating children will get four 2-hour sessions for each sport over 6 weeks. May saw the conclusion of the Volleyball and Netball camps, while the Football camp will be held in June. The last week of the summer camp will witness a qualifying round which will culminate into the mixed-gender Football tournament to be held on 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 2018.

The last in a series of 6, PSD conducted the final training workshops for 76 coaches part of Anantapur Sports Academy (ASA). # PSD Team Participates in Netball Tournament in Mumbai

A team comprising of 5 girls and 5 boys part of Sports PSD's Community Proaram in Bhubaneswar the opportunity got to participate in the One National Netball Cup 2018 in Mumbai, organized by Naz Foundation.



This was the first time these children had participated in a national-level tournament. and for many it was the first time travelling outside of Odisha. They got the opportunity to gain exposure by being at a national sports tournament, while also learning from and interacting with other young people from across the country.
