Initiating Community Sports Programs in Bhubaneswar

PSD will initiate community sports programs with underprivileged and marginalized children in Bhubaneswar from the beginning of September. These programs utilize sports as a medium to aid in the social, emotional, mental and physical development of children. They will utilize a multi-sport approach, where meaningful games and activities are implemented in a fun and enjoyable atmosphere, contributing towards the holistic development of children.



After the PSD team visited several schools and institutions in Bhubaneshwar, it was decided that the program will be piloted in two schools in Dumduma, the second largest slum in Odisha, as well as with children from the SOS Village, located on the outskirts of the city.

PSD has been documenting several programs and events taking place at RDT's Anantapur Sports Academy (ASA) this past month. The highlight was the hockey camps and coach training programs held at the Anantapur Sports Village (ASV) as well as the grassroot schools, by former Spanish International, Andreu Enrich, and his Stick for India coach volunteers from Spain. Moreover, PSD produced a video documentary of the hockey program at the ASA.

PSD also covered the Softball South Zone Senior Championships, for boys and girls, the Andhra Pradesh State Boys Boxing Tournament as well as the Andhra Pradesh Ranji Cricket camp at the ASV.

Lastly, PSD documented the participation of the hockey boys in the Rotary Invitational Tournament held in Bangalore, from which they emerged as champions.

PSD will soon be undertaking the needs assessment study for the RDT sports coaches, at all levels of their operations. This will involve evaluating RDT's coaches to assess the areas wherein they require continued professional development.
