The camp was held for a duration of 6 days at the end of March, at two community schools, namely Vivekananda Sishu Kendra (VSK) and Binapani Sishu Mandir (BPSM).



The Netball camp taught the children the basics of Netball, and developed certain life skills such as non-verbal communication, raising voice against violence, hygiene awareness and my rights.
