PSD Celebrates Children's Day with Activities in Bhubaneswar

PSD organised 4-days of friendly sports competitions across 5 of its community program centres in the lead up to Children's Day on the 14th of November, 2016. Competitions were held in the games of Dodgeball, Beat the Ball and Touch and Run.



The focus of these activities was to provide each child with an opportunity to participate and express themselves through competitive yet fun games. The 4-days of activities saw the participation of a total of 273 children - 153 boys (56%) and 120 girls (44%).

PSD Delivers 3rd Round of Training to RDT Coaches

PSD delivered the 3rd round of training workshops for two batches of Development Trust's (RDT) Anantapur Sports Academy (ASA) coaches from the 21st to 25th of November, 2016. The 2-day training workshops were delivered to 11 Academy coaches and 13 Grassroot Cricket coaches



The workshops focused on understanding and effectively implementing Talent ID, effective communication in coaching, in particular the coaching styles, feedback mechanisms and solution-based coaching as well as planning and organization, with a focus on session planning.

The 3rd round workshop will be delivered to another two batches of Grassroot coaches in early February, 2017.
