Three KBC Sports Leadership Workshops Conducted

PSD, in collaboration with PRIA (Society for Participatory Research in Asia) and MFF (Martha Farrell Foundation), delivered another round of the KBC Phase 2 Sports Leadership Workshop across 3 locations in West Bengal (Siliguri & Kalimpong) and Haryana (Panipat).



The workshops were held in February on the following dates: in Siliguri from 10th to 12th in partnership with CINI, Kalimpong from 17th to 19th in partnership with Saptashree Gyanpeeth School and in Panipat from 24th to 25th. A total of 92 youth participated across the 3 locations, with 53 girls and 39 boys.
