

### KBC Leadership through Sports Workshop delivered in B'lore

Following-on from the Gender My Way workshop held in November 2018, PSD in partnership with Martha Farrell Foundation and Society for Participatory Research in Asia conducted the Leadership Through Sports workshop with 17 youth participants (41% female) in Bangalore from 12<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> of January 2019, with the support of local partners Makkala Jagriti.



The Leadership through Sports workshop builds the capacity of youth participants, by refining skills such as planning, organisation and communication, to be able to effectively facilitate activities and events within their communities.

Aryan Pattanayak is a student of Class 8 of Sri Sathya Sai School situated in the Dum Duma slum of Bhubaneswar. PSD's Community Sports Program (CSP) has been working in the school for the past two years, where several students, including Aryan, have tapped into their full potential through the structured sport for development program. Aryan's family lives in the Bhagalpur area of Bhubaneswar, where his father runs a small 'kirana' shop (grocery shop).



Before joining PSD's CSP, Aryan was an introvert and had issues communicating with his classmates. He had few friends in school and did not make much effort to make new ones. Aryan was disinterested in his studies, as well as other extra-curricular activities.

### PSD delivers 2<sup>nd</sup> Workshop for Youth Female Leaders in Ajmer

PSD conducted a 2<sup>nd</sup> training workshop for 19 female youth leaders part of Mahila Jan Adhikar Samiti and HAQ's football program in Ajmer District, Rajasthan from the 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> of January 2019. This workshop progressed from the 1<sup>st</sup> training held in September 2018, by building on the facilitation skills and coaching knowledge of the youth leaders.



The 2<sup>nd</sup> training workshop delivered classroom and practical sessions on effective game/activity delivery protocols, warm-ups and cool downs as well as long-term planning.



### 3<sup>rd</sup> Teacher Training Workshop held as part of CSP in BBSR

In order to ensure the long-term sustainability of the Community Sports Program (CSP) being implemented in Bhubaneswar in partnership with Tata Trusts, PSD has been undertaking a series of workshops to train school teachers to effectively deliver the sports-based curriculum.



The 3<sup>rd</sup> workshop started on the 27<sup>th</sup> of January 2019, and will be held on successive weekends. Along with having 4 school teachers, the 3<sup>rd</sup> workshop included 8 young student leaders from 4 schools, who will also be trained to assist in the future delivery of the program.
