

Training of PE Teachers at Sherwood Public School

Pro Sport Development (PSD) held the first of its three training programs at Sherwood Public School in Hyderabad. PSD will be preparing a customized Physical Education (PE) curriculum for the school, providing training to its PE teachers to effectively implement the curriculum, and periodically reviewing its progress. The first training focused on providing the PE teachers with an understanding of the curriculum as well as the concept of Long Term Athlete Development (LTAD), Physical Literacy and Fundamental Movement Skills (FMS). It also provided a practical understanding of implementing the curriculum for the first Trimester, by learning about the lesson plans, their learning outcomes and the games and activities to conduct within these lessons.



The training, held for a total of three days, discussed the skills required by the teachers important in implementing a quality PE curriculum, including sound planning and monitoring, effective communication, safety of play areas and first aid. Finally, the practical sessions of the training allowed the teachers to understand effective delivery of the games and activities within Trimester 1 of the curriculum, to facilitate the children in grasping its learning outcomes.



The next training, to be undertaken after a period of three months, will focus on implementing the curriculum for Trimester 2. Moreover, it will also include a review on the progress of Trimester 1.
