PSD, in collaboration with PRIA (Society for Participatory Research in Asia) and MFF (Martha Farrell Foundation), continued the success of the joint gender and sports training camp, this time in two locations in Uttar Pradesh, namely Babina district, near Jhansi and Chholapur, near Varanasi.

The camp in Babina district, held from the 22nd to 24th of July, in collaboration with local partners Margshree Charitable Trust, saw the participation of 103 youth (53 girls & 50 boys). The camp in Chholapur, held from 29th to 31st July, in collaboration with local partners Sahbhagi Shikshan Kendra, saw the participation of 64 youth (37 girls & 27 boys).

PSD restarted the Community Sports Program in Bhubaneswar with a 2-day M&E training course for its coaches and trainers, to ensure they understood the upgraded M&E and impact assessment systems put in place for the Community Program, and their role in ensuring the effective implementation of the same.



This was followed by the coaches and trainers facilitating a baseline survey among the participants of the Community Program, and their school teachers, specially designed by PSD to gauge the impact on the children.

Community Sports Program Restarts in Bhubaneswar



PSD's Community Sports Program in Bhubaneswar restarted in 5 existing and 3 new centres this past month, after the summer school holidays. The restart of the program also saw the use of a revamped, restructured curriculum prepared by PSD, utilizing a greater number and variety of games.



The new centres added were Vivekananda Shiksha Kendra in Saliashree Vihar, Kalinga Vidya Mandir and Vivekananda Shiksha Kendra in Dum Duma. The program now reaches out to a total of **543 children on a weekly basis**, of which **240 (44%) are girls whereas 303 (56%) are boys**.
