

CSP Endline Data 2017-19 shows interesting results



In an effort to better understand the impact of the Community Sports Program (CSP) supported by Tata Trusts in Bhubaneswar, PSD collected a range of data from children in the program before the start of the same ('baseline'), during the program ('midline') and at the end of the program ('end line'). Endline data was collected for 622 children from 7 schools. However, only information from the 412 students (173 females and 239 males) who took part in the program for the entirety of its two-year duration was analysed.

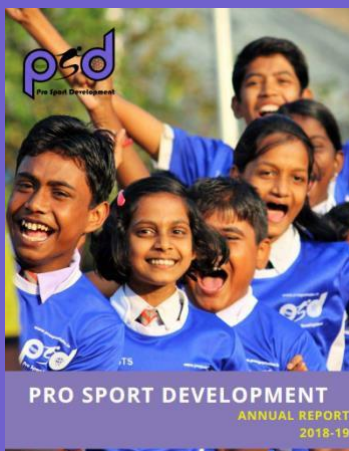

This year, the program will be introduced in 3 locations across India; Bhubaneswar (Odisha), Panipat (Haryana) and Deoghar (Jharkhand).

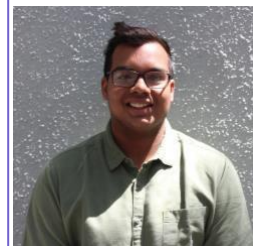
PSD other than providing sports inputs within the program, will also independently implement the program in Bhubaneswar.
